BLOIS SAYS THE DELIVERY OF VOICE OVER THE INTERNET THAT I-P TELEPHONY PROVIDES, HAS ALREADY PROVEN TO BE A FEATURE THAT CONSUMERS WANT.

DEMAND FROM USERS, HE SAYS, IS SHAPING THE WAY I-P TECHNOLOGY IS DEVELOPED.
