The [Accelerated Reader \(AR\)](#) Enterprise program promotes independent reading and documents students' growth in reading comprehension. To participate in the program students choose an Accelerated Reader book by looking for the blue AR spine label in the IWA Elementary Level Library. Reading level is also indicated on book spines with colored stickers which expedites and simplifies the selection process for students.





HEB Center

The H.E.B. Tennis Center has been a fixture in the landscape of Texas tennis for more than 40 years. The tennis center boasts 21 lighted, laykold outdoor tennis courts as well as a pro shop, lounge, and full locker room facilities.

The most recent addition to the center is the Mildred and Lloyd Sessions Tennis Pavilion, a \$1.4 million covered facility that houses 3 covered courts, brand new locker rooms and bleacher seating for the covered courts as well as an observation deck over looking four of our outdoor courts.

The facility also is home to the Jim Greenwood Memorial Stadium court which can seat up to 2500 people for high profile events. From 1998-2000, the Greenwood Stadium played host to the Omni Living Legends Benefit, an exhibition designed to raise money for tennis programs benefiting underprivileged children in our area. During that three year period, tennis fans in South Texas were treated to exhibition matches that featured John McEnroe and Jimmy Connors, Monica Seles, and Lindsay Davenport, and Jim Courier and Carlos Moya. In its history, the H.E.B. Tennis Center has also hosted prestigious events such as the Southwest Conference championships, the NCAA Men's Division I national championship and the Omni National Small College Championships. Annually, the tennis center hosts over 15 adult and junior tournaments, including the H.E.B. Collegiate Team Championships. This event hosts 16 NCAA Division I men's teams each March and is the longest running men's team tournament in the country!

The tennis center is also the home facility of Tennis Success, a program run by Corpus Christi native and former junior program participant Ronald Elizondo. This program is privately funded and provides free tennis lessons to inner-city children.


IWA admissions decisions are based on a student's academic and behavioral readiness, matching the student's ability and needs with our educational programs.



The Austin Street Athletic complex will include:

- purchasing of required equipment to orchestrate field events,
- installing batting and golf cages, and
- providing storage for sporting equipment

It will be used annually by hundreds of student-athletes, in all three classes and compete in track and field, cross country, soccer, baseball,

The field, built in 2000, currently includes a cinder practice track with six lanes. It is a host site for soccer games and is also a practice facility for our football teams.




- installing a natural grass turf on the soccer field and regrading the field,
- replacing the cinder track with an all-weather surface,
- constructing areas for the high jump, discus and shot put; creating a long jump runway with pad and vault box,
- purchasing field equipment
- installing new lighting
- providing for the safety of the facility

The Austin Street Athletic Complex will be used annually by hundreds of students, who participate in physical fitness and compete in track and field and golf.

Incarnate Word Academy's athletic field, built in 2000, currently includes 42" lanes and a soccer field. The field is a host site for soccer games, track, cross country, and baseball teams.

While this facility has served our students well, the track has outlived its usefulness and needs to be replaced. At the same time, improving and expanding the facility will be a great benefit to our students, coaches and our schools.

INCARNATE WORD ACADEMY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Since the inception of the Incarnate Word Academy Scholarship Program in 1980, 55 permanent scholarships have been established. Incarnate Word Academy is honored and profoundly grateful to those who have initiated the scholarships and to those who have generously contributed to the funds. Hundreds of students have benefitted. The permanent scholarships, which are generally initiated to honor loved ones, have helped families who might otherwise have been unable to afford the full cost of tuition at Incarnate Word Academy.

Types of Scholarship Funds

There are two types of scholarship funds: annual and permanent. An annual scholarship fund responds to current needs. Typically, contributions to this type of fund consist of \$1,000 or less and the entire fund is distributed within twelve months of receipt.

A permanent scholarship is an endowed fund. An endowed scholarship fund provides a predictable source of funding in perpetuity and will always memorialize or honor the name(s) placed on it. A minimum contribution of \$10,000 is required to endow a fund. A donor has the option of funding the scholarship over a three to five year period. The basic plan underlying an endowed fund is simple. The principal of the fund is never spent. It is invested and the earnings are used to fulfill the purpose(s) for which the fund was created.

We can provide information about funding alternatives (cash, marketable securities, planned gifts); the process involved in creating an endowment (agreement terms); naming options (your own, a loved one, a business); and donor benefits (personal satisfaction, reports, interaction with scholarship recipients, donor recognition society).

We invite you to join us in continuing the tradition of making a Catholic education available to qualifying students. Currently, the Scholarship Program includes 22 scholarships in process toward permanent status. (Scholarship funds of \$10,000 or more may be established as permanent endowments.)
